

National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (Postgraduate) NEET PG is an examination that serves as both a qualifying
and ranking assessment for students who wish to pursue
postgraduate in MD/MS and PG Diploma courses in either
government, private or deemed medical colleges across
India.

Who is eligible to participate in NEET PG counseling? Candidates who have qualified the NEET PG exam are eligible. Last year's qualifying scores are mentioned below. How many rounds of counseling?

There will be 4 rounds of counseling: Round 1, Round 2, Mop-up Round and Stray Vacancy Round.

Who is responsible for counseling?

MCC at All India level for AIQ/DNB & Deemed Universities and State counseling authorities for state quota seats.

2022 counseling recap Last year around 1,75,063 wrote the NEET-PG exam and around 90,000 (50th percentile) candidates qualified.

Choose an agent who is younger than you, so that he can outlive you and help with claim settlement in an unfortunate event. It can also be bought online directly from the company's website. How much cover to take is a personal choice, but recommendations are 20 times annual income (ideal), 10-15 times annual income (optimal) or at least 20 times annual expenses plus liabilities like a loan. Sum insured cannot be increased later unless you opt for the life stage protection option to increase sum after marriage, childbirth etc.

You can select one of the reputed large companies with a high settlement ratio and low premium. Some examples are LIC, HDFC, SBI, ICICI etc.

Term insurance recommendations at Wealthcon are

- Buy only pure-term insurance.
- The policy period is a personal choice but till 70 years of age is adequate




Initially a stress reliving exercise now has become a wonderful hobby for me when ever I get time more so on holidays

# Egypt - A Fascinating destination

Egypt is known for its ancient civilization which dates back to 5000 years. Their contribution to the world in the field of architecture, medicine mathematics, astrology, paper and papyrus arts, painting, preparation perfumes and Agriculture and many other fields is phenomenal. There are number of monuments which are both the ancient and the present wonders of the world like "The Great Pyramid" and also number of world heritage sites. Most people know only about the Pyramid. Let me place before you a brief account of our Tour of Egypt


# Pyramids of Giza:

They are situated about 15 km from Cairo on the outskirts, over the west bank of the Nile. It was one of the tallest buildings in the world till 1960, before the completion of the Empire State building -New York. This monument is 4700 years old and continues to be in a perfect shape, with many parts of the structure remain unexplored and mysterious even today. It was 481 feet tall and now it stands at 455 feet with the surface plaster worn out. This is a pyramid complex of three large

pyramids and few smaller pyramids of their wives and children. The largest of the pyramid is of Khufu or Cheops the Pharao of the 4 th Dynasty who ruled Egypt around 2600 B C. The one a little smaller, which is 471 feet is that of his son Kafre, and the smaller one which is 223 feet belongs to Menkaure. The Complex has yet another attractive statue of "The Sphynx" – which is a mythical creature with the head of a human body and the body of a lion. The face appears to be That of the Pharao Kefri himself. The face has been disfigured. The burial chamber with its granite sacrophagus is intact and thousands of people continue to visit the place.

### Alexandria:

It is the second largest city in Egypt on Mediterranean sea shore. It is an ancient Township founded by Alexander the Great in 3rd century BC, and the famous queen Cleopatra lover of Julius Caesar and Antonio ruled this place in 30 B C. At another ancient wonders of the world "the Alexandra Lighthouse" was situated here.









Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa, considered as 7 wonders the middle ages is still intact. It has series of Alexandrian tombs, many artistic statues, decorated door ways and and paintings of the yester years which still look fresh. It was a Funerary between 2 nd to 4 th century AD.

# Pompey's pillar:

This is a 25 metres high Monolithic granite coloumn standing since 300 A D, near by is the ancient ruins of The Roman Amphitheatre and the Roman Temple

Alexandria was a great centre of learning during the rule of Ptolemy's, and was home to the largest Library in the world which was destroyed during war. In the year 2002 a new library has been inaugurated which has a unique structure and has the unique distinction of being the 6 th largest library in the world.

### The Mummies:

The practice of preserving the dead bodies of the kings, Queens and nobles was prevalent in Egypt during the ancient times. These were kept in a closed chamber with all the comforts for their journey of life after the Death. We can see these Royal mummies whose bodies have been mummyfied and preserved for more than 3000 years in the royal mummies hall in the Egyptian national Civilization Museum in Cairo.

### The Nile:

It is the longest river on earth which Travels 6600 kms from its origin before it joins the Mediterranean sea, It is the lifeline of Egypt. It travels 10 countries before it enters Egypt. It originates from the Victoria lake in Tanzania and brings the fertile soil from these African countries and spreads on both the sides along the banks in Egypt. One of the largest Dams is built across this river at Aswan "The High Dam", creating one of the largest man made Lakes which spans across an srea of 5250 sq.kms, known as "The Nasser Lake", It controls floods and also produces hydro electricity which is enough to supply power to the entire country and there is adequate water for irrigaton to crops all round the year. Flow of water is regulated to faciltate movement of medium sized vessels and cruisers for tourism and transportation of goods.

After visiting the tourist places around Cairo and Alexandria, we flew to Aswan City and visit some of the most beautiful tourist Destinations like Temple of Philae deicated to the Isis, an Egyptian God located on an island.

# Temple of Abu Simbel:

A must see temple which is a world heritage site, about 270 kms from Aswan. These are two rock cut temples of 13th century BC, dedicated to God Amun built by the Pharao Ramses 2. The entire temple was relocated to the present site rock by rock as it it could have submerged in the Lake.

## Luxury Cruise from Aswan to Luxor:

This is the best way to visit some of the temples on the way. At Ko ombo we visited the beautifutemple dedicated to the crocodile God Sobek. As we cruise ahead at Edfu we visited another beautiful temple dedicated to Horus – the Falcon God. We sailed to Luxor, which is the same ancient city of Egypt well known as Thebis which was the capital city of many of the pharaos. At Luxor there are two well known World Heritage sites, Temple of Luxor and Temple of Karnak. These two temples are vast and magnificent with tall monolithic pillars and statues of the rulers and their dieties. Many generations of rulers have supplimented to the earlier structure.

# Valley of Kings

The Pharaos who ruled from Thebis (present day Luxor ) between 1600 to 1100 BC, did not build pyramids instead they had their burials in rock cut decorated graves with all the luxurious belongings which were needed for Life after death. So far 64 Graves have been excavated. Among all these the grave of Tutankhamun is most well known for the amount of Treasure that was unearthed from his grave in 1922. He ruled between 1334 to 1323 BC and had died at a very young age. Though it was a small grave, it was packed with more than 5400 items, and the Gold and Jewellery weighed a hooping 1200kgs. All these have been shifted and displayed at a Museum in Cairo. If there could be so much wealth in the tomb of a not so famous Pharao, it is only left to be imagined how much wealth may have been looted from the tombs of well known Pharaos. Yet another monument of significance in the vicinity is a temple and also the tomb of a lady Pharao who was a very famous ruler known as Hapshetsut.

After this we were taken to a famous Beach Resort Hurghada on the shores of Red sea. This resort is very popular among Russian and European tourists. It is very famous for sea sport activities like scuba diving, snorkelling and many more.

From here we proceeded to Cairo for our return journey back to Mumbai. This is a very brief account of our tour of Egypt



# Cologne- the art and media city of Germany



Cologne, founded and established in the1st century CE as the Roman Colonia Agrippina, was later named as Colonia which became the Köln of modern Germany. Located on one of the major trade routes linking east and west Europe, it was a free imperial city of the Holy Roman empire and one of the largest European cities in mediaeval and renaissance times. One of the most heavily bombed German cities during WWII it reduced the population by 93% and destroyed almost all of the millenia-old city centre. The post war rebuilding restored the major historic landmarks and is filled with foreigners.

Located on the Rhine, it is a major art centre with many museums and galleries. The University of Cologne is one of Europe's oldest and largest Universities since 1388 with over 50,000 students, 11% being foreigners .It has 3 Max Planck science institutes, a major research centre for the Aerospace industry and European Astronaut centre headquarters. The Ludwig museum has regular exhibitions on different themes eg. the Expressionists.

Cologne is a media centre- one finds many TV channels and Media firms -youngsters can make their own You-tube channel talking about their Themes, make Comedies or give Tips. The German trade fair is very popular in the computer and video games industry, with over 350,000 visitors last year.

I first visited Cologne in 2018, when my son Mihir joined Fresenius university as a Professor. The Gothic architecture Cologne cathedral is a world renowned World Heritage landmark, always under renovation and can be seen from the air. It took over 600 years for construction and the tower is over 157 m high. The remains of the Roman fortress can still be seen as also the old houses in the old city. Walking along the Rhine, watching the ships, the icy cold winds make you quiver. One can walk past the houses of the rich and famous in Rodenkirchen, where dogs and humans are looked at suspiciously, but where one can picnic and play on the sand or frolic in the sea on a hot

summer day. A Rhine cruise takes you past the various towns, historical ruins and vineyards where one can stop and taste the different wines.

Cologne like all old cities is filled with culture. The famous Cologne Carnival since over 5 years runs from 11.11 at 11.11 am to Ash Wednesday. The highlight of the street festival is Shrove Monday in Lent with over 1 million visitors.

The many pubs, favourites of tourists and locals are filled with young and old ,downing the small glasses of local Kolsch beer (Mihir's favourite is the Indian pale ale fresh from the taps). Ehrenfeld, where Mihir lives, where one cannot get a flat for love of money, is totally bohemian. Men with ponytails and women with flowing skirts sit on the footpath or on sofas pulled onto the road, sketching, sipping wine or just chatting, while kids run around with gay abandon, cyclists and cars beware. Garage sales of used clothes, toys and impromptu sketches abound. Best of all, if you don't want something just dump it outside your house-someone will find a use for the bookshelves, sofas, paintings or vintage crockery.

Like all popular cities, the restaurants range from the formal fine dining Maybach to the many Indian restaurants offering North or South Indian or Mughlai food and Sarvana Bhavan offering over 50 varieties of dosas to the roadside Kebap, Sushi and Thai food joints-there is always something for every budget and palate.

The Cologne language "Kölsch" is a dialect with its own Literature and songs like every region of Germany. One has truly learnt a dialect when one can abuse in that and understand their jokes.

Cologne is well connected to all major cities in Germany and the whole of Europe, Ryan Air offers cheap flights which we freely avail of during our monthly trips to visit Mihir from Vienna. In summer, Germany offered 9 Euros tickets for a month's travel by buses or trains to any destination in Germany. We visited Aachen(the speedily growing University town where one can see an Indian student or Indian restaurant at almost every street corner), Wuppertal with the hanging bridge, Dusseldorf - the 'Milan' of Germany, Vaals on the Netherland border (enjoying fried fish fresh from the sea)and Monschau on the Belgian border where one can buy yummy Belgian chocolates.

Cheers to Cologne with its eclectic blend of old and new!!.


