He was started on IV Fluid (RL) with IV Pantoprazole 40mg and was given test dose of IV ceftriaxone with Tazobactum .He Developed Hypotension and collapsed. Treated with Adrenaline Inj. Hydrocort, Inj. Deriphylline and cardiac massage and Assisted Ventilation with Ambu Bag. Patient did not respond and died at 2.10pm. (Only 44 min stay at the hospital). Dr Yeshavanth

whitely informed me few minutes before the assault, smelling their behavior, they may cause harm to him and the hospital. I posted the matter in the doctors' group and requested the doctors to come to hope hospital.. Within 15 minutes, 30 of us, reached his hospital Before that the Patients attenders have started abusing the treating doctor Dr.Yeshavanth whitely. Who is a surgeon. They also manhandled him. They caused damage to the hospital, Broke the windows and door shutters. We consoled the doctor. By that time, as I informed SP, he had sent police who controlled the crowd. We all went to police station and filed an FIR against the culprits. Arrested the man who assaulted the doctor. They apologised at the police station and requested us not to file an FIR. But I refused, and told them a message should be sent to the public that what will happen to someone who misbehaves with doctors and insisted for FIR. Next day we called a press meet. Nearly 20 doctors attended. We briefed the media about the incident. And clarified that there was no fault on the part of treating doctor and told them that patient's relatives can't misbehave with medical community. If they have a doubt on the treatment provided by the doctors, they can file a case and ask for justice, but they cannot take law in to their hands and misbehave and assault any doctor. I requested them to give awareness to the society regarding the same.

"Every run is a work of art, a drawing on each day's canvas"

It was in the year 1987 and our early days in the Government medical college of Bellary. I was a localite and often used visit college campus to meet hostelries. It was on a Sunday as I went there; two of our classmates were getting ready for a running competition. It was a real puzzle for me as medical college students are traditionally regarded as bookworms and physically not strong. Both of them were getting ready for running 10 kilometres marathon starting from Royal theatre covering Durgamma temple ,round the monolithic rock and back to royal theatre. They are none other than Dr.Hanumantharaju. B.K now a well known Urologist of Bengaluru and Dr.R.N.Malavegowda now a well known Orthopaedic Surgeon of Ramanagara. As I struggled to follow them on my bicycle they easily completed this task very easily! Kudos to their stamina....

It is a long journey of 37 years our professional life but still both of them have nurtured their sports passion wherein Dr.R.N.Malavegowda chose cycling and Tennis and Dr.Hanumantharaju.B.K, long distance running.

Born in 1969 at Nelamangala Dr.Hanumantha raju.B.K had his studies at Jindal public school and MES College, Malleshwaram of Bengaluru. During school days he was very active in athletics, particularly in long distance running of 1500 and 5000 meters. During these days he has won in much state level interschool competitions.

For practise purpose he used to run from his home to school covering 11 kilometres from Nelamangala to Jindal and used to send his books and uniform along with his brothers, who were studying in the same school. He was a good Kabaddi and Kho-Kho player also. During this period he was also chosen to participate in RD NCC parade (1987) in Delhi from Karnataka and Goa.

He has won gold medals in 800 ,500 and 5000 meters in state level inter medics held at St John's medical college in 1988 - 1989 and represented Gulbarga University in marathon and Kho-Kho. Under his tenure as the sports secretary of the students union many sports events were held at our Bellary Medical College.

His main inspiration for his passion for long distance running was his P.T master in his school days who used to make them to run up to a hill behind an school for about 10 kilometres on Saturdays. Now this hill has been taken over by the Indian Air force.

After his MBBS from Govt medical college Bellary from 1987 to 1993 he did his MS General Surgery in JSS Medical college Mysore and DNB urology in Apollo Hospital

- Dr. Madhusudhana Kariganuru, Siraguppa

Chennai. He worked as Assistant professor in JSS Medical Collage and then shifted to Bangalore, Adichunchanagiri Medical College and then to Rajarajeshwari Medical College as a Urologist. At present he is attached to Kempegowda Hospital Bangalore and has his own Urology Centre - Rajajinagar Kidney Care Hospital. He is also visiting consultant in few Hospitals in West Bangalore.

Even with his busy professional schedule he continues to run long distances. It was bit of an initial struggle in Bangalore and now with a decent professional life he again started running practice. He has run many half marathons, 3 full marathons (Bangalore and Mumbai) and two trail runs of 33 kilometres at Malnad and Vagamon Cochin. He will be running 12 hours stadium run is July 2024 wherein he will covering 65 kilometres

When asked about the secret about his passion He says "The more I run, the more I love my body". In spite of his busy urology practise, he will try to make time to run at least 5 kilometres and on the free days and Sundays he will 15 - 20 kilometres with his Urology colleagues. He is fortunate enough to have good Urology group who run together on Sunday in Cubbon park and participate in Marathons held all over India.

When asked about his advice for young doctors, he says Health is wealth and he requests all the doctors to make time for some physical activities to keep themselves fit and healthy. He has motivated many doctors, friends to start physical activities like running, cycling, swimming.

He is part of a running group in Bangalore called Run addicts (Rajarajeshwari Nagar). They advise everyone regarding running and practice schedule for marathons. It is a non profit and non commercial organisation dedicated to promoting fitness and rural education. The money they get from registration will be utilised to buy books, tables, chairs for children in rural areas. Interested can join the group for advice regarding running and fitness.












