From the Desk of

!!Greetings from editorial committee of IMA Focus!!

Thank you all for conducting & participating at Independence Day at various branches with true patriotism.

But this time the horrible incident which happened at R G Kar Medical College at Kolkata on safety of women doctors has become a set back for our profession. We have been targeted often with atrocities on allopathy doctors but the recent horror and involvement of the goons', glove in hand with the known persons in the medical field is a big blow to the profession both outside and within the hospitals. The incident has been propagated to different part of the world though many TV channels and media.

Every one now understand the situation of doctors on duty at various hospitals in India & so many factors playing a role to make a doctor less powerful & less committed. Unless both the government and local public give support to Medical professionals, the horrible things are likely to repeat in different forms. Horrifying to note that the internal members of the hospital themselves were part of the incident to avoid exposure to public. Henceforth, even a little clue for violence and assault on oneself should be taken care and to inform the caring persons at hospital or home. But in reality if you visit the medical institutions & hospitals (which should set an example of all round safety to be maximum) in most places there is still women safety is a challenge in India due to various reasons at all levels.

Ensuring the safety of women doctors in India is crucial, especially given the challenges they face. Here are some key points and measures that can help enhance their safety:

- 1. Increased Security Personnel:** Deploy more trained security personnel, particularly during night shifts.
- 2. CCTV Surveillance:** Install comprehensive CCTV cameras throughout hospital premises to monitor and deter any suspicious activities
- 3. Proper Lighting:** Ensure all areas, especially parking lots and corridors, are well-lit to prevent any potential threats
- 4. Secure Resting Areas:** Provide secure duty rooms with locks and basic amenities for doctors to rest safely during long shifts
- 5. Controlled Access:** Implement strict entry and exit controls to limit access to authorized personnel only

6. **Alarm Systems:** Install alarm systems that can be easily accessed in case of emergencies
7. **Implementation of the Central Protection Act (CPA):** Enforce the CPA to protect healthcare workers from violence
8. **Awareness and Training:** Conduct regular training sessions for staff on safety protocols and how to handle emergency situations, self-protection kits, etc.
9. **Support Systems:** Establish support systems, including counseling services, for doctors who experience harassment or violence

10. **Legal Recourse:** Ensure that there are clear and accessible legal pathways for women doctors to report incidents of harassment or violence.

I feel, these measures can significantly improve the safety and working conditions for women doctors in India.

I congratulate all our office bearers of IMA KSB, President and Secretaries of various branches who submitted the memorandum to the concerned authorities and holding meeting with the health minister for bringing out the better safety of women doctors in our state.

Secretary's Message

Dear esteemed members of IMA KSB,

Greetings from the State branch!

Wishing a very Happy Gauri-Ganesha festival to all! May God bless you and your family with good health, wealth, happiness and peace!

The month of July 24024 started with one of the important activities: Doctors Day celebration! IMA KSB honored 12 esteemed and accomplished senior members on the occasion. Local branches celebrated the occasion with various activities including blood donation camp, free health check-up, sports activities, cultural programs and Felicitation of their members.

The state welcomed the much awaited Monsoon! The well distributed rains across most part of the state, initially was a welcome relief. However, the rains became furious and heavy rains have caused serious across many parts of the state. Inundated places, disruptions in the transport, electricity and landslides across the Western Ghats posed serious challenges. Floods have occurred across many parts of the state. Karnataka government has activated the disaster management cell and started relief measures. Water has been released in large volumes from brimming dams, agricultural activities have picked up across the state. Release of more than the double the expected amount of water to neighboring state has cooled down the water wars! However, it was a nightmare in neighbouring Kerala. The massive floods and catastrophic landslide in Kerala causing large scale death and destructions. IMA KSB expresses heartfelt condolences to the lives lost in the tragedy, including some of the IMA members. We will extend our helping hand to the IMA Kerala as required. Release of more than the double the expected amount of water to neighboring Tamil Nadu has cooled down the water wars tempers between the states. Damaged and broken crest gate of TB dam resulted in loss of large volume of water causing severe concern and anxiety among the farmers and the public alike and had become an issue of political tug of war between political parties. Apprehensions and political war were set to rest with repair of the gate. Now, with heavy rainfalls in the catchment area, the dam is almost full and the farmers have heaved a sigh of relief.

IMA KSB Elections: As per the schedule, the election has been started with publication of election notification at June issue of Focus 24. Members had applied for various posts. After the last day of withdrawal of nominations, many posts have been filled with unanimously. Elections are going to be held for central council members for both the years, chairmen of building committee and by-laws committee. Ballots have been already posted. Duplicate ballots can be asked for from 1 September 2024. The whole election process is happening with full sanctity as per the schedule.

878th SWC meeting: An emergency meeting was held on 17/8/24 to discuss about withdrawal of healthcare services on 18/8/24 as per the IMA HQ directive, to protest against and seek justice for the victim of Kolkota incident. The meeting unanimously agreed to go ahead with the protest as per the headquarters and permitted for a reasonable spending on the meeting requirements like erecting the pandal and others.

879 SWC meeting: A virtual meeting had been called to ratify the award committee report for teacher's day awards 2024 and ratifying the nomination for Dr. B. M. Alur oration for IMA KSB AMS Conference 2024 to be held at Raichur. Dr. Suresh Sagarad name was ratified for the same. Teacher's day awards selection list was ratified. Few suggestions were given including increasing the awards for clinicians and agreed to take up the issue for next year. Permission was given to host the teacher's day award function along with IMA KSB AMS Conference at Raichur on 15/9/24 and for judicious spending towards the same (expenditure on awards, certificates, shawls and fruit/dry fruits baskets).

Protest against brutal murder of a ppst graduate student in Kolkota: A heinous crime was committed in a medical college in Kolkota, where a pg student of R G Kar medical college, Kolkota, was brutally attacked, suspicious of gang rape, torturing and murdered. The incident was a shock to the whole country and it was a national shame. The brutality and possible gang rape, efforts to cover up the case as suicide and brazenness to tamper with the evidence evoked severe reactions across the country. IMAGINE HQ took the issue seriously and planned for nationwide protest. The whole medical

fraternity including doctors from all walks of the profession, junior doctors and medical students actively participated and made significant impact on the case investigations. Honorable Supreme Court directed the case to CBI inquiry. The national President and his team along with the local West Bengal branch visited the ground zero, interacted with the students and the parents and assured them IMA's fight for justice to the departed soul, bereaved family and the medical profession at large.

IMA Karnataka and its branches very actively participated and held protest marches, meetings and other needful steps including extensive media coverage to highlight the sentiments of the medical fraternity and demanding for the justice.

Central law to stop violence against healthcare professionals: IMA HQ has intensified the demand for a central law to protect the healthcare professionals, which is a long pending demand of IMA. Kolkota incident has given momentum to press for it. The IMA reached out to the health minister and prime minister's Office to demand a speedy investigation and justice. In the background of increasing violence against doctors, especially, against the women healthcare force, demanded for a central law to tackle the issue. Hope, there will be safety at all medical facilities across the country. NMC issued safety guidelines to all medical colleges.

IMA KSB awards: Notice has been given inviting nominations for various categories of annual awards given during MEDICON 2024. It's time for the local branches and the individuals who have done well in the last one year to apply for awards and appreciation. We look forward to proactive initiatives from the branches to encourage members to apply. Similarly, the branches who have done excellent work should apply for various awards meant for the branches.

BNS and Medical negligence: The operationalization of the new criminal laws enacted by the government of India has concerns for the unintentional medical negligence. Medical negligence is neither intentional nor criminal in nature. The Indian penal code given a cleavage for discretion to the legal authorities for lenient consideration and quantify the punishment based on the merit of the case. However, unfortunately, the new criminal law has criminalized the medical negligence with severe punishment. This has caused serious concern among the medical professionals across the country. IMA HQ has taken note of the issue and contemplating legal course for justice. HQ is trying educate the members and the branches on the issue and has requested for financial contributions from the branches to cover for legal expenses. IMA HQ and the honorable National President have also made strategies to address the issue through legislative process. Accordingly, all the branches and office bearers across the country will meet the honorable

members of the parliament and submit memorandum and request them to support our efforts to decriminalize the unintentional medical practice and reassure the profession on this front.

President's speech: The President discussed the work done in a month's time and interacted with the members and also highlighted the various works done. Local branches response to the call to protest against Kolkota incident was well appreciated.

Sport activities: SOMANNA Memorial Shuttle and Badminton tournament: IMA Raichur successfully organised the sports meet on 10 & 11 August 24. Large number of teams participated and enjoyed the activity. IMA KSB President inaugurated the event

GST Collection: No headway on this front although efforts are on. IMA Malebennur branch paid its share this month,

Sub-committees: The Kannada Barahagarara Balaga is continuing its activities uninterrupted! 5th edition of the annual SAMMELANA held at Belagavi was a grand success. The weekly webinars are happening wonderfully. The participation of the Padma awardees and sharing their journey, experience and contribution to the society and the profession is highly appreciated. The team deserves accolades for their work. Public health subcommittee is organizing very good virtual meetings.

IMA AMS state conference: IMA RAICHUR is organizing the conference on 15/9/24 and the final brochure with scientific information has been circulated and registration has been stated. Dr. Suresh Sagarad, a senior physician and cardiologist from Raichur has been selected to deliver Dr. Alur oration.

Vice President's Message

Greetings from the vice president of IMAKSB.

It is a pleasure to give a report of the functioning of IMAKSB for last few months. The team of IMAKSB officials along with the senior leaders have been working hard to bring in some policy changes for the betterment of medical professional and healthcare professionals of the state. It's a proud moment for IMAKSB for having succeeded in getting the violence act against medical professionals amended by our state government. This new amendment is one of its kind in the entire country. The significant changes brought in this amendments as compared to the previous act for the punishment against the culprits extended from 3 to 7 years. These cases will be heard on a fast track by the district magistrate and not by a lower court because it is seven years imprisonment. Getting a bail for these culprits is not possible. The fear of long term imprisonment and ut being non-bailable should create fear in the public that they cannot take law in their hands.

There are also mentions in this law, for verbal abuses and social media abuse, persons who commit social media abatement they have punishment of minimum of three months imprisonment or a fine of ₹10,000. The new amendment also mentions about certain changes in the Karnataka medical registration act such as the renewal process would be as per the NMC guidelines. There is also mention about handling of quackery in the state wherein the Karnataka medical Council can have So motto cases against the quacks practising in the state this is a great victory to Ima KSB which has been fighting against quackery for a long period of time. Now the efforts of our

senior leaders in bringing out this amendment in collaboration with government of Karnataka should be applauded which all started in the IMA South zone CGP conference held at Gadag.

I will be failing If I don't thank all the three ministers who attended this conference and helped us bring this amendment especially the special interest taken by Shri HK Patil the Honble Minister for Law and Parliamentary affairs, government of Karnataka and all the officials of Ima KSB. I also thank Shri Dinesh Gundu Rao Sir minister of health and family welfare and Shri Sharan Prakash Patil honourable minister for medical education. In bringing these amendments it is our duty to report any type of healthcare violence to the appropriate authority when it happens there is no question of having fear or budging to the local pressure for not having reporting these cases. There are several further issues to be addressed for the medical fraternity and I pledge, I along with the support of all the seniors and the officials of IMA-KSB with the support and encouragement of the entire medical fraternity of the state will work for the betterment of medical professionals. I take this opportunity to also thank all of you for showing the solidarity and support for the Calcutta incident. Let our fight continue in this regard to bringing central law for violence against medical professionals. I take this opportunity to thank all my seniors and the entire medical fraternity of state for giving me this opportunity to serve as the state vice president of IMA KSB I am open for any type of suggestions and help when required. 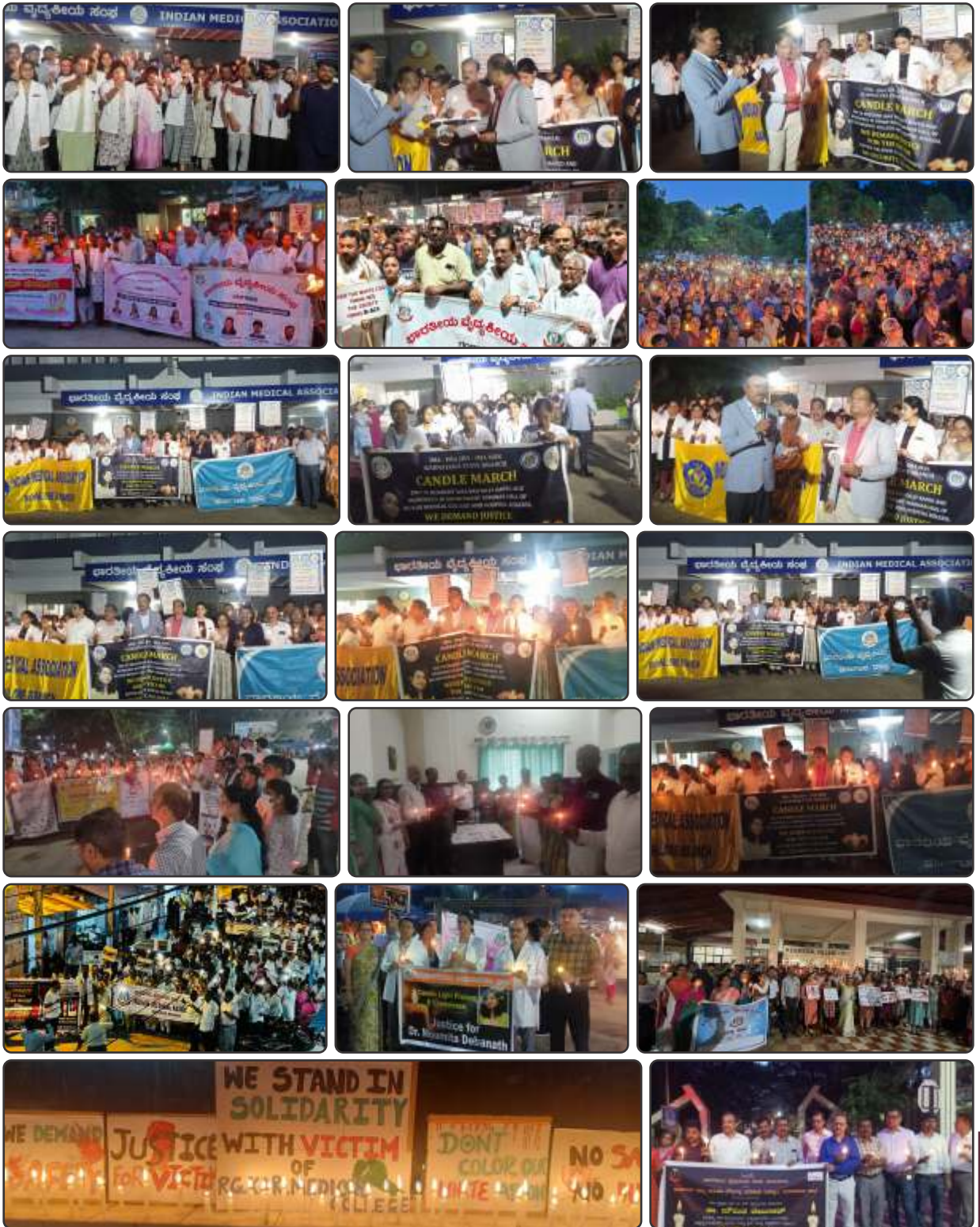

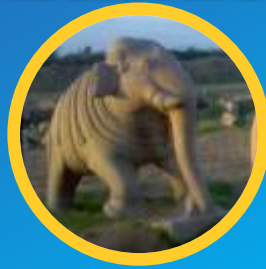
