Greetings from the IMA KSB !

The month of June was busy with multiple activities. Had two SWCs to discuss important issues and then we had patient safety collaborative meeting. There were serious concerns with NEET exams fiasco. Overall it was an engaging month.

876 SWC: Held on virtual platform on 16/6/24. As per the agenda the award committee report on selection of esteemed members to honour on the Doctors day-1/7/24 was presented and accepted. Dr. Shivakumar B Lakkol has been nominated as the protocol Officer for MEDICON 2024 to be held at Yelahanka.

877 SWC Meeting: The meeting was called to discuss and decide on the IMA HQ directive to host a consultative meeting on Doctor patient relationship and consumer protection act repeal for doctors issue, in the background of Apex court keeping away the advocates out of consumer protection act and suggesting same to other professionals including the doctors. The meeting discussed the issue in detail and permitted to go ahead and host the meeting. The meeting will be attended by prominent consumer protection act experts, activists besides the IMA delegates. The meeting will be hosted on 29 & 30 June 24 in Bangalore.

NEET Issues: The NEET UG & PG exam fiasco has seriously jeopardised the students' future. There was severe uproar on the issue across the country. IMA HQ has raised the issue with the union government. Government of India has initiated many measures including detailed investigations to find the root cause of the problem. Also assured the students quick

and suitable solutions to the problem. IMA has appreciated the corrective measures taken by the government and would wait for further decisions to resolve the situation.

IMA HQ & PSAIIF Collaborative meeting- Bridging the gap: Enhancing collaboration between doctors and patients in India: IMA and patient safety access initiative India foundation (PSAIIF) came together to discuss the issues related to patient safety and other related concerns at Bangalore on 29 & 30 June 2024. It was the initiative of our beloved national President Dr. R V Asokan. The meeting was hosted by IMA KSB. It was a unique and historical collaborative meeting between doctors, patient safety experts and patient representatives from various parts of the country. 43 learned members including 22 representatives and experts from PSAIIF and 21 doctors including IMA national President, vice presidents, chairman of HBI and others and 11 representatives from IMA KSB including President, Hon State Secretary, Hon treasurer, past presidents and other senior members. The 2 days Conclave deliberated the patient related issues on three broad headings; Universal health care, confidentiality patient data safety and health insurance. The members from both sides wonderfully discussed on the issues and arrived at a consensus, culminating in producing a vision document on the road ahead with historical BANGALORE DECLARATION! The National President, Chairman of PSAIIF, the founder member of the foundation and the IMA KSB President signed the document and released. This declaration will go a long way in achieving the goals as declared in the document and ensure better safety to the patients.

National President appreciated the initiative and successfully conducted the meeting.

Doctor's Day celebrations: The Doctors day has been celebrated with fanfare! The function was organised at Dr.Basavarajendra Auditorium. Sri. H K Patil, Honourable Minister for Law and Parliamentary Affairs, Tourism and Human Rights was the Chief Guest. 12 distinguished senior members of the organisation including 4 women doctors were awarded and felicitated.

President's speech: The President discussed the work done in a months time and interacted with the members and also highlighted the upcoming doctor's day celebrations and the preparations and doctor-patient relationship and patient safety consultative meeting as per the request of the headquarters.

Sub-committees: The Kannada Vaidya Barahagarara Balaga continuing its activities uninterrupted! The weekly webinars are happening wonderfully. Preparations are on for the annual conference.

VAIDYA PADMARU- compilation of the inspiring information on Padma Awardee doctors from Karnataka. A wonderful book with engrossing details
